



General Information

- Registration begins at 8AM and will remain open until just after the last coaches meeting at 2:30PM. Teams will enter through the left-most doors to the Arena's main entrance.
- Spectator doors open at 8:30AM. Admission is \$5 for adults/students; children 4 and under are free.
- Coaches meetings are at 8:30, 11:30 and 2:30. You only need to attend one. Both stunt and team information will be discussed at the 8:30 and 11:30 meetings. All meetings are in the Phoenix Room (to the right upon entering the Arena).
- Busses may drop teams off at the main entrance, but then must go and park. No busses will be allowed to sit in front of the building. Parking is available at multiple locations, see website or qualifying folder for further details. ***All Busses MUST park at Lambeau***
- If busses wish to leave during the day, they may get a pass from the attendant to return without having to pay again.
- No Carry-Ins allowed. PMI has the right to search anything that is brought into the arena.
- Concessions will be available throughout the day. They have tried to provide a larger variety of food, including healthier food for our event. Prices for items range from \$0.75 (snacks) to \$5.25 (fruit cup).
- Upon entering, paid athletes will have their hand stamped for entrance into the arena. Coaches will receive a COACH Lanyard.
- The stands behind the black curtain are for athletes only and their belongings. Please do not take up more room than needed. Seating on the floor is for spectators only. WACPC is not responsible for lost/stolen items, please leave valuables at home.
- There are locker rooms for changing please use quickly to allow other athletes to use the rooms. Three will be for girls and one for boys, please note signs.
- NO SAVING seats in the arena!
- Please be respectful of seating that has been taped off, this has been done by the Site Director.
- Lost and Found items will be brought to the announcer's table.
- WACPC apparel will be available for sale, while supplies last.

- Screen prints for names on back of clothing will be available for purchase.
- All athletes, coaches and participants are expected to comply with NFHS & WACPC rules and sportsmanship guidelines.
- Teams are responsible for reporting on time to the start of rotation based on their performance number. Performance times are approximate. We will try to stay as close to scheduled times as possible; we will not go ahead of schedule.
- Stunt groups will start their rotation at 15 minutes before they are scheduled to perform. Stunt Groups will report to the Photographer, Mat #1 (3 min), Mat #2 (3 min), In the Hole and On Deck based on rotation schedule. There will be no other mat time available. Stunt groups must be in school uniform as stated on the registration form.
- Teams will start their rotation at 25 minutes before they are scheduled to perform. Teams will report to the Photographer, Stretch/Tumble, Mat #1, Mat #2, In the Hole and On Deck based on rotation schedule. The photographer will be a block for 5 minutes, all other stations, 4 minutes. There will be no other mat time available.
- Panels A and B will face East/right as you enter the arena from the main entrance.
- Please have a backup CD available, and be aware that some “homemade” CDs do not play in all sound systems. Music may be checked before the start of competition and during the long break. It is recommended that a few seconds of blank “air” time be added to music on CD’s to ensure that the song is played in it’s entirety.
- Entrance/exit can be from side or back of mat, but it must be quick and immediate. Please exit the mat/court into the “shoot” (by the T-shirt sales).
- Please direct any comments/suggestions to the site director or district reps.
- Teams only - Please have your When We Were Young Production information completed and turned-in to at the coaches meeting or the When We Were Young table. This information was in your qualifying folder. Extras will be available at the WWWY table as well.
- Make sure that photographer forms are completed prior to the start of your rotation to ensure that you will have the full time allotted with the photographer. Candid shots will be available for purchase as well.
- There is a lounge available this year as just a place to “get away”. It is not very big, but it is only for the teams.
- WACPC board members as well as the UWO Titan Cheer team and parents are available for questions. If they cannot answer it, they will know how to get a hold of someone to answer it.
- Also there will be a full size basketball court down on the floor, with the main competition mat over it. Please remind your athletes that they need to step up onto the basketball

court. While the team is waiting to be announced, they may wait to the side or back of the mat, on the court.
