

# **ALL-STATE FINAL DETAILS**

## **DANCE**

- The dance candidate tryouts will be held during the first session (Pom) of State Dance in the North Hall.
- The final line-up will be posted at [www.wacpc.com](http://www.wacpc.com) the Tuesday morning the week of the event.
- Due to the complex scheduling, requests for specific performance times will not be honored.
- Please report to the All-State room 20 minutes prior to your scheduled performance time-block
- The routine requirements (score sheets) can be found in the *Competition Handbook* link on the website.
- Please make sure your routine, costume and shoes all comply with the NFHS rules for Spirit Groups.
- Music should be on one CD. It is best to have 3-5 seconds of "air" at the beginning and end of the actual music to insure the music plays in its entirety on the La Crosse Center sound system. MP3 players will not be accommodated.
- If your team did not qualify for State Dance, they can enter for free, IF they check in first at Team Registration. They must check in together...they will not be admitted separately. Only the number of team members and coaching staff that were originally registered and paid for will be allowed in for free.
- Parents and spectators must enter through the spectator entrance and pay the standard entry fee.

## **CHEER**

- The cheer candidate tryouts will be held during the Stunt Group session of State Cheer in the 'Old' Hall of Fame (HOF). Please see the [Brown County Arena Map](#) under the *Varsity Cheer* link on the website for the location of the Old Hall of Fame (it is accessible through the hallway beyond the warm-up area in the arena).
- As a reminder, you will perform on three 6'x42' cheer mats. Note that the third mat is flush with the wall (see [Cheer Mat Layout Sketch](#) under the *All-State* link). You may begin your tumbling passes off the mat. However, all skills must land on the mat.
- The final line-up will be posted at [www.wacpc.com](http://www.wacpc.com) the Tuesday morning the week of the event.
- Due to the complex scheduling, requests for specific performance times will not be honored.
- Seating is limited in the HOF. Only performer's team and family members will be allowed in the performance area (expect tight seating) at the designated time-frame (they will not be allowed in earlier to save seats). To make this a positive experience for all, please pass this information on to your team and parents.
- Two sets of three 6'x42' warm-up areas will be available to the candidates at an assigned time. Candidates will have to share the space with the other participants in the 15 minute time block (6 athletes max). Please report to warm-up at your assigned time; late comers will not be given extra time.
- The routine requirements (score sheets) can be found in the *Competition Handbook* link on the website. Tumbling "touch-downs" and "falls" will be deducted.
- Please make sure your routine complies with the NFHS rules for Spirit Groups.
- Music should be one CD. MP3 players will not be accommodated.
- If your team did not qualify for State Cheer, they can enter for free, IF they check in first at Team Registration. They must check in together...they will not be admitted separately. Only the number of team members and coaching staff that were originally registered and paid for will be allowed in for free.
- Parents and spectators must enter through the spectator entrance and pay the standard entry fee.
