Dear Coach,

Oshkosh North is excited to be hosting the 2010 WACPC Eastern Regional High School Dance Championships. While a list of teams in each division is listed on the website, the specific performance order line up will be posted the week of January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Please review this information and contact me immediately if there are any needed corrections. At this time you can see the other teams in your division and calculate the number of state qualifiers. Please review the WACPC state-qualifying policy on the website for an explanation of this policy. Also frequently check [www.wacpc.com](http://www.wacpc.com) for changes and updates to the line-up. No changes to the line-up will be accepted after **January 27, 2010**.

Please review your copy of the National Federation Spirit Rule Book and the online WACPC 2010 Competition Handbook. It is your responsibility as a coach to understand and follow all rules and policies. Please confirm that the head coach has taken the required online rules quiz. Remember – all Medical and School Liability Release forms must have been sent to the WACPC office prior to the competition. **YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE WITHOUT THEM!**

Enclosed you will find directions to Oshkosh North. A map is located in the back of your Competition Handbook. All teams must enter the building through Door 7, which is located in the west parking lot. Spectators must enter the building through Doors 1 and 20. **Teams may not enter through these doors.** Door 1 is located on Smith Avenue and Door 20 is located in the east parking lot, (closest to the field house). Bus parking is in the West Parking Lot (by the team entrance). There will be some spectator parking available in that lot as well, but spectators will **not** be allowed to enter door 7. Please inform your fans of this information.

We are happy to again be able to assign classrooms for teams to use. Please remind your athletes that this amenity is not offered at all regional sites and that in order to continue to have access to the classrooms, teams must treat them with care. It is most likely that your team will be sharing your room. Because of this, please be respectful with the amount of space your team uses and be ready to share the space with another team. We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items. Please leave all valuables at home. There will be Event Staff monitoring the hallways and classrooms; however classroom doors will remain unlocked. **ONLY ATHLETES AND COACHES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CLASSROOMS AND SURROUNDING HALLWAYS.** Please remind your fans and parents of this rule. This rule is for the protection of the athletes. Anyone violating this rule will be asked to leave the area. If problems persist, your team may receive a violation.

Concessions will be available throughout the day. A limited supply of clothing is also available for purchase while supplies last. If you preordered t-shirts, they will be available at registration. Someone will be onsite to print names. Spectator admission is \$5 for adults and \$3 for students 6 and up.

Please remind your parents and fans of the Sportsmanship and Videotaping policies. Also ask them not to save seats in the bleachers. Do not bring pillows, bags, etc. into the field house.
