The Watertown Dance Team is very excited to be hosting the 2010 WACPC Southern Regional Championships again! While a list of teams in each division is listed on the website, the specific performance order line up will be posted the week of January 25th, 2010. Please review this information and contact me immediately if there are any needed corrections. At this time you can see the other teams in your division and calculate the number of state qualifiers. Please review the WACPC state-qualifying policy on the website for an explanation of this policy. Also frequently check www.wacpc.com for changes and updates to the line-up. No changes to the line-up will be accepted after **January 27, 2010**.

Please review your copy of the National Federation Spirit Rule Book and WACPC 2010 Competition Handbook. It is your responsibility as a coach to understand and follow all rules and policies. Please confirm that the head coach has taken the required online rules quiz. If you have questions regarding this process, please contact Linda Schrage at schrage_cheer@yahoo.com.

Remember--All Medical & School Liability Release forms, registration forms, and payment must have been mailed to WACPC prior to the competition. **YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE WITHOUT THEM!**

All teams, spectators, and bus drivers **must enter through the main entrance**. Buses must drop the teams off at the main entrance, and **park on Carriage Hill by the soccer fields** as directed by the lot attendants. There will be a parent driver that is picking up and dropping off bus drivers so you don't have to walk. Also, there is a bus drivers room where you can relax and watch tv.

We cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items. Please leave all valuables, such as jewelry, at home. Only coaches and athletes will be allowed in the warm-up gym, locker rooms, and hallways. They must have a WACPC name tag and a wristband. Please notify your parents and fans of this. Anyone violating this rule will be asked to leave the area. If problems persist, your team may receive a violation.

A variety of concessions will be available in the Commons all day; no carry-ins please. Extra T-shirts will be available while supplies last. Spectator admission is \$5.00 for adults, \$3.00 for students 6 and up.

Please remind your parents and fans of the Sportsmanship and Videotaping policies. Also ask them not to save seats in the bleachers. Do not bring pillows, duffelbags, etc. into the gymnasium.
